



MBA Subcontractors Health & Safety Regional Competition Rules

MBA Subcontractors Regional Safety Competition Rules

The criteria for the audit and competition are:

- Proof of good standing in respect of workman's compensation insurance for you and all your sub
- contractors (either through FEM (recommended) or the compensation Commissioner)
- A Health and Safety plan;
- A site specific risk assessment which must include: safe work procedures and a monitoring and review plan;
- Disabling Injury Frequency Rate (DIFR);
- Written permission from the Principal Contractor for us to audit you on their site.

If your site complies with all of the above, you are eligible for our competition.

If you have a high Disabling Injury Frequency Rate (DIFR) on site it will affect your score and star rating. A Disabling Injury (DI) is when you have more than one shift lost on site. i.e. if the employee is booked off by the doctor for more than one shift or if he is returned to work on light duty, it is regarded as a DI. The DIFR is then calculated. The calculation formula and the sliding scale are on the last page of the audit schedule.

Once all of the above are in order, we will contact you to make an appointment for your competition audit. After the audit is done a detailed report will be sent to your company stating
