

Overview: Fixer Erector
Assist to erect, use and dismantle access scaffolding (Module 2)

The general worker training program is designed in accordance with Unit Standard 263247. Our training officers are CETA accredited. The title of Unit Standard 263247 is:-

Assist to erect, use and dismantle access scaffolding
(Erecting of Static and Mobile Towers, Independent and Birdcage)

The qualifying learner will acquire the necessary knowledge and skills to assist in a team to erect and dismantle a basic scaffold system. A basic scaffold system includes access tower, mobile and fixed independent scaffold, and bird cage scaffold. The qualifying learner will perform all tasks under supervision and instruction. This unit standard will serve, in conjunction with related unit standards, to develop the qualifying learner to function as a fixer in an access scaffold team.

Prior learning assumed to be in place on entering into this training program is as follows:-

- Communication at NQF Level 2.
- Mathematical literacy at NQF Level 2.
- Assist to erect an access scaffold tower on level ground to 2m high to platform at NQF Level 2.

This program runs over 2 days and the typical scope of the unit standard includes:

- Understanding the nature and scope of access scaffolding.
- Erecting access scaffolding.
- Dismantling access scaffolding.


